

2009 General Shale Brick Atlantic Sun Women's Basketball Championship

Game Notes: No. 3 Belmont 67, No. 6 Campbell 52

BELMONT

- * First-Team All-Atlantic Sun forward Jessica Bobbitt collected her 13th double-double of the season with 12 points and 11 rebounds. Only ETSU's Siarre Evans (16) has more double-doubles this season.
- * Bobbitt tied the Belmont school record for offensive rebounds in an A-Sun Championship game. Brandi Miller also grabbed six against Troy on March 13, 2003
- * Belmont won all three games with Campbell this season, limiting the Lady Camels to just 44.3 PPG. Dating back in the series, the Bruins have won 10 of their last 11 against the Lady Camels
- * The Bruins advanced to the semifinals of the General Shale Brick Atlantic Sun Women's Basketball Championship for the third time in the last four seasons.

CAMPBELL

- * The Lady Camels failed to advance past the first game for the eighth straight year. The last time they won a Championship game in 2001, winning a semifinal contest against Troy.

A-SUN CHAMPIONSHIP NOTES

- * Belmont will take on Jacksonville in the second semifinal on Friday at 2:30 p.m. CT on CSS. Belmont won both the head-to-head meetings, winning in Florida, 51-45 on Dec. 4 and closing out the regular season with a 45-43 victory in Nashville.
- * The top four women's seeds (No. 1 ETSU, No. 2 Jacksonville, No. 3 Belmont and No. 4 Mercer) have advanced to the semifinals for just the second time in the Women's Championship in the last nine years (also in 2007).
